Living Liturgy for Cantors

This resource will help cantors prepare themselves to sing the responsorial psalm. This book offers cantors insight into how the psalm is connected to the readings of the day as well as to their daily lives. Gaining a sense of these connections, cantors will be able to sing the psalm with greater understanding and to lead the assembly more effectively in surrendering to the mystery of Christ made present in the Liturgy of the Word.

A Lyrical Vision: The Music Documents of the US Bishops

The publication of the US Bishops' document on music in the liturgy, *Sing to the Lord* (2007), has prompted Fr. Edward Foley to review the overall contribution of the Bishops to liturgical music since Vatican Council II. He explores the history and content of the US Bishops' three previous statements on music in worship. In tracing this history, Foley illuminates the stages that led to *Sing to the Lord* and compares this most fully developed document with its predecessors. This concise history and analysis—illustrated with sets of comparative tables—will be a valuable resource for all who study, prepare, and lead music in Catholic worship.

A word about *Cantus Missae—Jubilare Deo*: The 2007 music document *Sing to the Lord: Music in Divine Worship*, published by the U.S. bishops, directs that: “Care should be taken to foster the role of Latin in the Liturgy, particularly in liturgical song. Pastors should ensure that the faithful may also be able to say or sing together in Latin those parts of the Ordinary of the Mass which pertain to them.” (#61) “Each worshiping community in the United States, including all age groups and all ethnic groups, should, at a minimum, learn *Kyrie XVI*, *Sanctus XVIII*, and *Agnus Dei XVIII*.” (#75)

Adhering to the spirit of documents from the USCCB and in order to assist your community in learning these chants, *Celebrating the Eucharist* will now include *Kyrie XVI*, *Sanctus XVIII*, and *Agnus Dei XVIII*. In addition, *Gloria VIII* will be included for those communities able to sing a more difficult chant. The complete *Cantus Missae—Jubilare Deo* is published in *Sacred Song*.

The entire staff at Liturgical Press, along with the Benedictine monastic community of Saint John's Abbey here in Collegeville, wish God's continued blessings upon your ministry to the Body of Christ.
