Dear Pastoral Musician,

Greetings from Collegeville!

I would like to take this opportunity to update you on the forthcoming mass settings we will be publishing in our missal *Celebrating the Eucharist* and our music resource *Sacred Song*.

Archbishop Timothy M. Dolan, President of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, has authorized Diocesan Bishops to permit the gradual implementation of various musical settings of the Order of Mass from the *Roman Missal, Third Edition*, effective September 2011. In the issue of *Celebrating the Eucharist* that begins on August 21st, 2011, the last two pages of music include the new Gloria, Sanctus, and Mysterium Fidei from the *Mass in Honor of Saint Benedict*. While the paragraph above the music states that these settings should not be sung as the prescribed parts of the Mass until Advent, this issue of *Celebrating the Eucharist* went to the printer before the above authorization was granted. Therefore, if your diocesan bishop permits the gradual implementation of mass settings, in September you can begin singing the new arrangements of the Gloria, Sanctus, and Mysterium Fidei from the *Mass in Honor of Saint Benedict* as the prescribed parts of the Mass. 6. *Missa Pacem* by L. Randolph Babin
7. *Mass in Honor of Saint Paul* by Kevin Christopher Vogt
8. Selections from the Latin chant mass *Missa Iubilare Deo*, Vatican Edition
