Dear Pastoral Musician,

Greetings from Collegeville!

November 27<sup>th</sup> marks a new beginning for the dioceses of the United States as we start using the third edition of *The Roman Missal*. Since October 1<sup>st</sup>, we've shipped thousands of copies of our Missal to parishes throughout the country. Musicians have been purchasing our online Mass settings and several dioceses have selected one of our Masses as their diocesan Mass. We're honored that the *Mass in Honor of Saint Benedict* by Robert LeBlanc, has been chosen for the ordination of Monsignor David Kagan as the seventh Bishop of the Diocese of Bismarck.

As I have previously announced, *Celebrating the Eucharist* will include eight Mass settings and *Sacred Song* will include ten Mass settings. Both editions will also include the *ICEL Chants for the Order of Mass*. The chart below outlines the Mass settings you'll find in each resource:

When you click on the title of a Mass, you will be directed to the information page about the Mass. Here you can download a review copy of the Mass by clicking on the "See a sample" button directly below the cover image. You will also find information about the Reprint License for the Mass if you need to make copies for your choir and/or cantors. For those mass settings that have additional components such as guitar, brass, C-instrument, etc., information about those editions is also provided.

The new 2011 Music Supplement is being mailed to your parish, to the attention of Music Director. This Supplement will completely replace the “S” section in your current accompaniment book and includes all the Mass settings listed above. When you receive the Supplement, remove and discard the current “S” section and replace it with the new one. There are also 18 new/revised hymns in the Supplement plus updated indices. We have several exciting new resources that I’d like to call to your attention:

- If you’d like to expand your music program, check out our revised edition of the multi-year (three year) hymnal **Sacred Song**, which now includes the Order of Mass with ICEL chants. If you currently subscribe to our “classic” edition of *Celebrating the Eucharist*, when you switch to *Sacred Song* plus our “liturgical text” edition of *Celebrating the Eucharist*, the cost is the same over the three-year life of the hymnal. - We’re publishing the first-ever, one-of-a-kind ritual edition of **The Easter Proclamation**, the *Exsultet*. Your deacon or cantor will treasure this lovely ritual book as they chant the *Exsultet* at the Easter Vigil. See page 4 for details.
- **Lift Up Your Hearts** is a small resource (4¼ x 6¾) containing the Order of Mass, with ICEL chants, plus ten Mass settings. An affordable resource, the cost is only \$1.49 when you order 210 or more copies. See page 5 for details.
- **The Psallite Mass: At the Table of the Lord**, by The Collegeville Composers Group, is receiving excellent reviews around the country. This unique Mass is included in both *Celebrating the Eucharist* and *Sacred Song* and could easily be sung a cappella during your weekday Masses. See page 6 for details.
- The DVD **Lord, Teach Us to Pray** offers 25 three-minute video sessions on the Mass. Start out each choir rehearsal or liturgy planning meeting by viewing one of the sessions. An effective way to help people reflect on the Mass for the community as a whole and on what it means to them personally. See page 7 for details.
- Also on page 7, you’ll find: **Chants of the Roman Missal**, a study edition of the ICEL chants for celebrants, cantors, and musicians; **A Commentary on the Order of Mass of the Roman Missal**, insights from liturgical scholars to help you understand the revised Order of Mass; and a best seller **The Genius of the Roman Rite**, explaining the rationale for the new translations by considering the wider context of the Rite itself.
