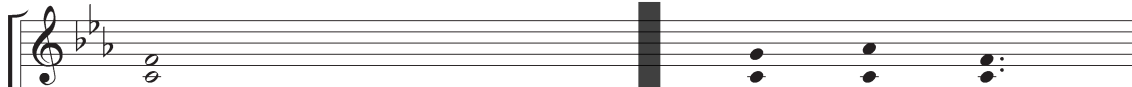


***Option I:** A - rise, Je - ru - sa - lem, stand on the height.

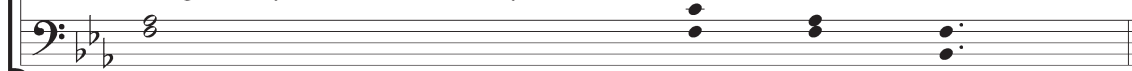
Verses Baruch 5:1-2, 5-7, 9; Isaiah 12:3-6
