Verses (Independent) *cf. Psalms 111:2-5, 7-9b, 6a, 9c; 138:4-6, 8bc*

Cantor / Choir:

1. Great are your works, O LORD, to be pondered by all who love them.

 You give food to those who fear you, keep your covenant ever in mind.

Performance Notes

The verses may be superimposed as shown on the previous page (with the text sung metrically or free), while the other parts vocalize to "oo" or hum over the first half, responding with "so is your word, so is your word;" or the verses may be sung separately (using the same tone, as shown on this page).
